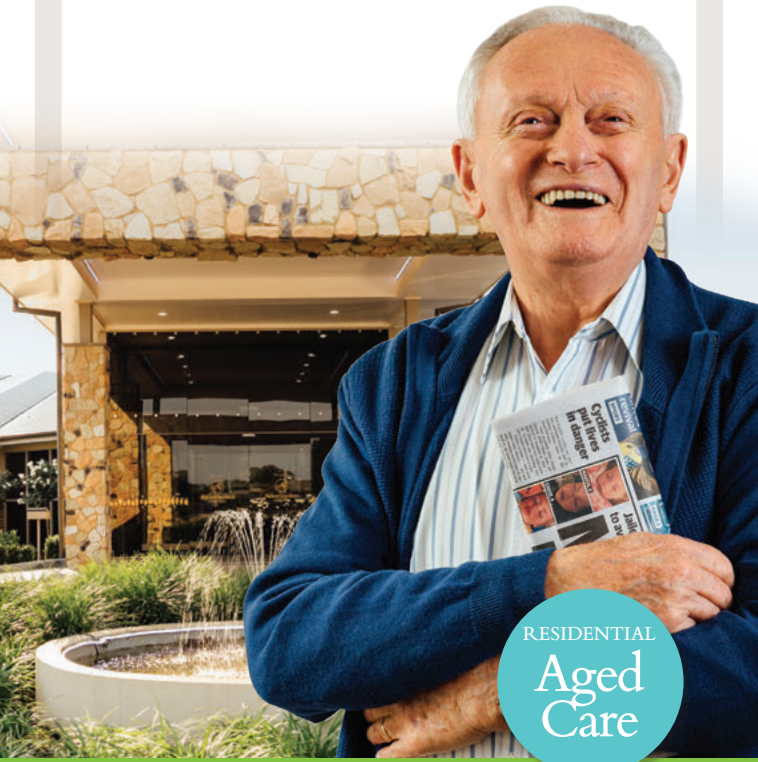

Bapcare Abbey Gardens Community is a vibrant residential aged care community in Warragul. Abbey Gardens services the Warragul and West Gippsland communities, providing residential and respite care in beautifully crafted surroundings.

Abbey Gardens is a lively and welcoming aged care community.

We provide numerous opportunities for socialising – our cinema is home to movie nights, our on-site bar boasts a happy hour and we run many group activities.

Abbey Gardens is designed to act as a hub for the broader Warragul community. Our on-site café has a recreational area for kids, catering to families and other community groups. Every three months, we host a local artist who works with our residents to produce their own art, which is then exhibited during our wine and cheese night. And our resident-led gardening club includes local horticultural students.

Our community is run by Baptcare, a not-for-profit organisation with more than 70 years of experience in caring for older people.

Features of Bapcare Abbey Gardens Community

At Abbey Gardens, you will have your own private room. We also have a number of shared areas and facilities for you to enjoy, including:

- **Landscaped gardens, a central courtyard and a BBQ area**
- **Numerous lounge and recreational areas including an on-site bar**
- **A cinema room**
- **An on-site café with a kids' play area**
- **An on-site hairdressing salon and private spa room**
- **A private dining room**
- **A chapel/space for spiritual reflection.**

We also offer a number of additional services, including delivery of daily newspapers and fresh flowers to your room.

You will have access to a wide range of health services, and trained nurses and a registered nurse on-site, 24 hours a day.

- > An electric Hi-Lo bed
- > A bedside table and comfy chair
- > A ceiling fan and individual heating
- > An overbed light
- > Internet access and a smart TV



Who is eligible for a place at Baptcare Abbey Gardens Community?

Abbey Gardens is a residential aged care community for older people who need a higher level of care than what can be provided in their own home.

With registered nurses on-site at all times, we are accredited to provide all levels of residential care, short term (respite) care, specialist dementia care and end-of-life palliative care. The scope of care we provide means we are equipped to accommodate our residents' changing needs, should it be required.





How to apply for a place at Baptistcare Abbey Gardens Community

1. Apply for residential aged care through the My Aged Care website. Call **13 BAPTCARE (13 22 78)** and we can guide you through the process.
2. My Aged Care will arrange an ACAS assessment visit to determine your care needs.
3. Appoint an authorised representative (Power of Attorney) if necessary.
4. Get an income and asset assessment. This will determine your aged care fees and whether you qualify for government funding.
5. Choose the Baptistcare residential aged care community that's right for you. You may wish to consider a respite stay to see if the community meets your needs.
6. Call **13 BAPTCARE (13 22 78)** to arrange a tour of your chosen community and fill out an application form.
