Who is eligible for a place at Baptcare The Orchards Community?

Baptcare The Orchards Community is a residential aged care community. This means it is for older people who need a higher level of care than what can be provided at home.

We welcome everybody who requires residential aged care, and strive to provide an inclusive community for all, no matter their beliefs, financial situation or background.

For respite stays, both government-funded (i.e. for people who are ACAS-approved or on a Home Care Package) and self-funded places are available.
