Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) is a government-funded program designed to help you stay living independently at home. If you're eligible, you may be asked to make a co-contribution, depending on your circumstances.

## Who is the Commonwealth Home Support Program suited to?

CHSP could be right for you if:

- \* You only need a small amount of support to keep living independently at home
- \* You're currently on a lower-classification of Support at Home and are waiting for a higher classification to be approved, with approved access to some additional CHSP services
- \* You're on the waiting list for Support at Home and have been approved to receive CHSP support in the meantime

Your services will be delivered by a dedicated Care Manager and group of Care Workers, supported by a multi-disciplinary team of Registered Nurses, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists, other Allied Health professionals and an experienced local management team.

BaptistCare's size and experience enable us to provide, or easily access, the full range of services and supports that are eligible under a Support at Home program, from simple help around the home to highly complex clinical care needs.

For customers in Tasmania who are receiving social support group, transport and a meal on the same day only the fee for social support group is charged.
